TODAY'S GAME:

Today's game marks a historic moment in the 23 year history of the Monmouth University Football program, the team's first against a Football Bowl Championship opponent. Monmouth is coming off a 27-19 loss to Holy Cross last week, after starting slow and falling behind 21-3 in the first 29 minutes of the game. MU dominated the final 31 minutes but a comeback bid fell short as the Hawks were unable to overcome four turnovers. Central Michigan hosts its second consecutive home game after hosting Oklahoma State at Kelly/Shorts Stadium last weekend. The Chippewas, under new head coach John Bonamego, fell short of upsetting the Cowboys, 24-13.

The Hawks look their first win of the 2015 season but it will have to come against a FBS program that has won 16 conference titles and has seven bowl game appearances. Last week against the Crusaders, Monmouth committed four turnovers and had a field goal blocked but still had the opportunity to tie the game before a drive stalled on the HC 22 yardline with time running out. Cody Williams became the 15th quarterback to start a game for the Hawks, racking up 296 yards of total offense. All-league running back Lavon Chaney had 130 yards of total offense while junior running back Lavon Chaney had 130 all-purpose yards. Monmouth's defense settled down after the first half, allowing 84 yards in the final two quarters. To be successful against Central Michigan, MU will have to limit its penalties and stop two of the Mid-American conference's best in quarterback Cooper Rush and senior defensive back Kavon Frazier, who was just named MAC West Defensive Player of the Week.

Central Michigan hung with Oklahoma State throughout the contest last Thursday, even taking a 13-10 third quarter lead. The Chippewas, led by first year Head Coach John Bonamego, were chosen fifth in the MAC West in the preseason media poll. CMU quarterback Cooper Rush ran for 51 yards and threw for 225 while scoring the Chippewas' only touchdown against OSU. Rush set a bowl record with seven touchdown passes in last year's last second loss to Western Kentucky in the Bahama's Bowl. Defensively CMU returns five starters on defense from a season ago. Central Michigan owns a 23-3 record against FCS opponents all-time.

WILLIAMS CLOSE TO SETTING FIRST TIME STARTER RECORD

Last week's Holy Cross game began the Cody Williams era as the Hawks' starting quarterback. Over the 23 seasons of football, Monmouth has had 15 different starting quarterbacks (QBs which started a significant number of career games), with only four earning wins in their first starts. Williams' 258 yards against the Crusaders ranks second behind Dan Sabella's 263 in 1994. The Springfield, Mass. native became the first freshman to start at quarterback for Monmouth since the 2009 season when Kyle Frazier started against Wagner.

HAWKS CHOSEN SIXTH IN PRESEASON POLL

Monmouth University was picked to finish sixth in the 2015 Big South Preseason Coaches Poll. Coastal Carolina was picked to win the conference earning 15 first place votes and 139 total points. Right behind them was Liberty with 129 points and six first place points followed by Charleston Southern (106 points) and Presbyterian (72). Gardner-Webb was chosen fifth with 57 points while Monmouth was just four points behind with 53. First year program Kennesaw State was picked seventh with 32 points.

Monmouth finished 6-5 overall and 1-5 in conference in 2014, its first season in the Big South. In addition to Basile and Sieczkowski, the Hawks had five other members earn all-conference honors. MU returns nine starters on defense and six starters on offense, including junior RB Lavon Chaney.

DID YOU KNOW?

Former Hawk defensive back Jameson Zacharias is a graduate assistant with the Chippewas. Zacharias, a defensive back, played for Monmouth from 2010 to 2013, finishing with 43 tackles in 35 career games.

HEAD COACH JOHN BONAMEGO



John Bonamego is in his first season as the head coach of the Chippewas. He is the first CMU alum to lead the football program since Bill Kelly in 1951-66. Bonamego, a Paw Paw native, was a wide receiver/quarterback as a Chippewa. He was a walk-on who earned varsity letters in 1985-86 and twice earned the Iron Man Award as the defensive scout team player of the year. Bonamego has spent the past two seasons as the Detroit Lions' special teams coordinator. Last season, he helped lead the Lions to an 11-win season, their most victories since 1991, and a playoff berth. Bonamego has 27 years of college and professional coaching experience, highlighted by 16 years in the NFL as an assistant, primarily as a special teams coordinator. Among all college football head coaches, he has the second-most years of NFL experience (16 years) after Jim Mora at UCLA.

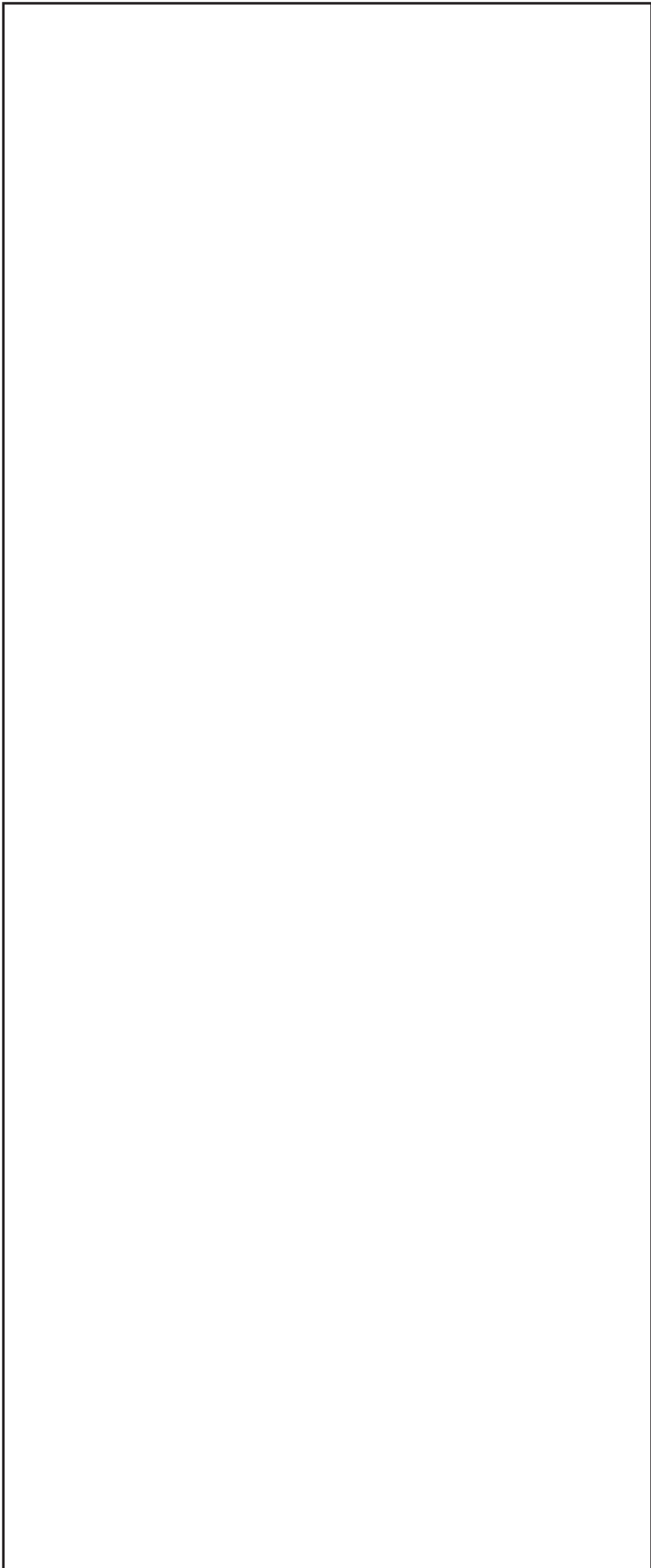

CHANEY PICKS UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF IN 2014

All-Big South running back Lavon Chaney picked up where he left off in 2014, when he led the league in all-purpose yards. Chaney was a yard short of his fourth 100-yard rushing performance, finishing with 99 yards on 20 carries. The junior added another 31 yards receiving on four receptions for 130 all-purpose yards. He was thrust into the starting role last season after KB Asante suffered a season-ending injury in a week four win over Lehigh.

BASILE TIES CAREER MARK FOR TACKLES

First Team All-Big South safety Mike Basile tied a career-high with 10 tackles against the Crusaders. Basile, who earned Big South Rookie of the Year honors in 2014, also tied his career mark for solo tackles with nine. Last season Basile was second on the team with 78 tackles but first in solo stops with 59.

CRUSADERS GET AMBUSHED

With Monmouth losing four senior wideouts and 61 percent of its total passing yards in 2015, the Hawk passing attack will have a fresh look. One of the returners with the most experience, junior Darren Ambush, had a career day against Holy Cross. Ambush finished with 106 yards on six receptions to lead all receivers, including an 81 yard touchdown in the closing seconds of the second quarter that jump started the Monmouth comeback attempt. He was second on the team in 2014 with three touchdown receptions while finishing with 23 catches for 327 yards as a sophomore.

DEFENSE SHUTS DOWN CRUSADERS IN SECOND HALF

After allowing 217 yards in the first half to the Crusaders (Trailing 21-9), Monmouth out gained Holy Cross 241 to 84 in the final 30 minutes. In the third quarter, Holy Cross had eight yards on a pair of three and out drives as Monmouth was unable to close the gap as a kick was blocked. Monmouth held the ball for over 12 minutes of the third quarter and 20 minutes of the second half.

DIMITRIUS SMITH'S CAREER DAY HIGHLIGHTS D-LINE PLAY

Redshirt senior Dimitrius Smith, one of the leaders of the defensive line, tied a career-high seven tackles against Holy Cross. Smith had five solo tackles and a tackle for a loss. Senior Andrew Jurczynski had Monmouth's only sack of the day.

NEXT MAN UP FOR MU DEFENSIVE LINE

The MU defensive line took another hit as senior defensive end Jack Eisenstadt left the game in the first quarter with an injury. Aside from Smith and Jurczynski, Monmouth will start a pair of freshmen up front in Zach Talley and Michigan State transfer Andrew Foster.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

Monmouth welcomes a pair of new coaches to the sideline for the 2015 season. Scott Lakatos, formerly of Georgia and Rutgers, will mentor a deep secondary in 2015 while former Colgate Raider Andrew Kirkland will coach the outside linebackers. The 2015 season marks the return of Head Coach Kevin Callahan coaching a position, handing the middle linebackers. Defensive Coordinator/Associate Head Coach Andy Bobik will coach Monmouth's defensive line this season.

THREE HAWKS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH

Redshirt junior John Sieczkowski and sophomores Mike Basile and Alex Thompson were each selected to the preseason All-Big South team. Basile was a First Team selection and Sieczkowski was a second team pick in 2014. Monmouth was the only school to have sophomores featured on the all-conference preseason team. Basile, who hails from nearby Brick Township, was the Big South Defensive Rookie of the Year in 2014. Sieczkowski and Basile started every game last season while Thompson started 10 of 11 games as a true freshman in 2014.

UP NEXT FOR THE HAWKS

After opening at home for just the seventh time in program history, the Hawks will embark on a three-game road trip, beginning with today's game and then a pair of games in New York City against Wagner and Fordham. Wagner is the only program that Monmouth has played all 23 seasons it has sponsored football.

MONMOUTH EXTRA POINTS

• Monmouth will be without all-conference defensive end **Darnell Leslie** for the 2015 season, after the Quince Orchard High School product was suffered a season-ending injury during training camp.

• After forcing 26 turnovers in 2014, Monmouth failed to force one in the season opener against Holy Cross. The Hawks finished with a +7 turnover margin last season are sitting at -4 after one week of 2015.

• Monmouth is now 5-18 all-time in season openers, 3-4 when opening at home.

• The team announced that seniors **Hakeem Valles, Ed Royds, Andrew Jurczynski** and **Joe Johnson** will serve as team captains for the 2015 season.

• Monmouth safety **Deonta Fair** was the lone true freshman to start for the Hawks in week one. The Hawks will be one of the younger teams in the FCS this season with only four of Monmouth's 22 starters yesterday are in their final year of eligibility in 2015.

• The Holy Cross game saw the debut of highly touted wideout **Reggie White Jr.**, who finished with five receptions for 39 yards and a long of 13. In the fourth quarter White displayed his athleticism leaping in the air to grab a high pass and recovered Monmouth's onside kick.

• WR **Pat Gray** (SR former DB) and Ugo Ezemma (FR) had their first career catches against Holy Cross. Gray had a pair of catches, including a 30 yard reception in the fourth quarter. Ezemma had a pair of catches for 13 yards.

• Eight out of the nine leading tacklers for the Hawks in 2014 will be returning in 2015, with the ninth being **Darnell Leslie**.

HOLY CROSS 27 MONMOUTH 19

Sept. 5, 2015 • Monmouth Stadium • West Long Branch, NJ

WEST LONG BRANCH, NJ - Cody Williams completed 22-of-33 passes for 258 yards and a touchdown in his Monmouth Football debut, but the Hawks opened the season with a 27-19 loss to Holy Cross Saturday afternoon at Monmouth Stadium.

Monmouth almost overcame a trio of turnovers when the Hawks drove down the field to set up a 27-yard field goal from Matt White with 1:18 remaining to cut the deficit to eight. The Blue & White made things interesting as Reggie White Jr. recovered John Coleman's onside kick in stride at the Holy Cross 49-yard line. MU drove down to the 22 but Luke Ford intercepted Williams' third down pass in the end zone with 14 seconds left to end the Hawks' threat.

Chaney finished with 130 all-purpose yards, including four receptions for 31 yards. Williams also rushed 15 times for 38 yards, while Zach Welch matched his yardage on five carries. White Jr. also contributed five receptions for 39 yards and recovered an onside kick late in the fourth quarter. Pat Gray chipped in with a pair of grabs for 36 yards.

Mike Basile led the Monmouth defense with 10 tackles, nine solo, and a pair of pass breakups. Dimitrius Smith and Joe Johnson also had five tackles apiece, while Andrew Jurczynski had a sack.

Holy Cross quarterback Peter Pujals was 16-of-26 passing for 165 yards and a touchdown. He also ran for 38 yards and a touchdown. Diquan Walker ran for a team-high 51 yards and a touchdown on nine carries, while Gabe Guild carried the ball seven times for 48 yards. Brendan Flaherty caught four passes for 22 yards and a touchdown, while Jake Wiecezorek had three receptions for a team-high 45 yards. Kalif Raymond had three catches for 27 yards and Lucas Nikolaisen hauled in two passes for 25 yards.

After the Hawks went three-and-out on the first possession of the game, Holy Cross responded with a four-play, 42-yard drive, punctuated by Walker's one-yard touchdown run. The key play on the drive was Gabe Guild's 33-yard run to the Monmouth one-yard line on 3rd-and-2.

Monmouth responded with an 11-play, 54 yard drive that culminated with Matt White's 38-yard field goal. Williams converted a 3rd-and-11, connected with Hakeem Valles on a 23-yard pass, before Chaney ran for another first down on 3rd-and-3. On the next play, Williams scampered for 14 yards, while Holy Cross was assessed a 15-yard penalty for a late hit out of bounds. But the Hawks' drive stalled and White split the uprights from 38 yards out, cutting the deficit to 7-3.

Holy Cross countered with a seven-play, 85-yard drive that Pujals punctuated with a 15-yard run up the middle for a touchdown. The Crusaders got on the board once again, capitalizing when Williams couldn't handle a snap out of the shotgun deep in Monmouth territory. Holy Cross recovered at the five-yard line and, after a five-yard penalty against the Crusaders, Pujals connected with Brendan Flaherty on a 10-yard touchdown pass to make it 21-3.

The Crusaders punted to the Monmouth 19 with 34 seconds left in the half. But Williams connected with Ambush on a screen and the junior wide receiver cut through the defense for an 81-yard touchdown. The Hawks went for two, but Reggie White came down with the ball out of bounds at the back of the end zone, leaving the score at 21-9 at the half.

After a scoreless third quarter, Monmouth cut the deficit to 21-16 on Chaney's two-yard run on a direct snap. The run capped a 13-play, 56 yard drive at the 13:25 mark of the fourth quarter. The Hawks converted their third fourth-down conversion of the half on a seven-yard sweep by Ambush to the two-yard line before Chaney punched it in on second down.

But Holy Cross turned a pair of Monmouth turnovers on their next two possessions into two Connor Fitzgerald field goals at the 9:52 and 5:11 marks to push its lead to 27-16.

The only head coach in the history of football at Monmouth, Kevin Callahan has developed a winning tradition in West Long Branch. Callahan, whose 126 wins is 13th among active coaches at the FCS level, ushered in a new era for MU football when the Hawks joined the Big South Conference in 2014.

Beginning his 23rd season at the helm of the Hawks, Callahan has amassed a 126-103 record while his teams have captured five conference titles in the past 18 seasons. Along the way, Monmouth has been ranked among the top 20 in total offense on two occasions and in total defense five times. Meanwhile, numerous players have earned conference, regional and national honors. Regarded as an outstanding coach by his peers, Callahan served as the President of the FCS Football Coaches Committee in 2007-08 and has been a member of the committee since 2002. Under his watch, six former Hawks have earned spots on NFL rosters, including All-Pro wide receiver Miles Austin of the Philadelphia Eagles. Most recently, wide receiver Neal Sterling became the second Hawk to be drafted when the Jacksonville Jaguars took him in the seventh round of the 2015 NFL Draft.

Callahan led the Hawks to a 6-5 record in 2014, including the programs first Big South Conference win on November 22, 2014 against Gardner-Webb. Six student-athletes earned All-Big South honors, including freshman safety Mike Basile and senior wide receiver Neal Sterling being named First Team. Basile was also named Big South Rookie of the Year, while running back Lavon Chaney became the first newcomer to lead the league in all-purpose yards in six years. Off the field Joe Johnson was named to both the Big South and Capitol One All-District II Academic teams.

In 2013, Monmouth's first season as an independent since the 1995 season, the Hawks faced their most daunting schedule. Playing a 12-game regular season for the first time in program history, the Hawks opened with No. 2 Montana State- the highest ranked opponent that MU has ever faced. The season also saw the Hawks host an Ivy League opponent for the first time, with Monmouth handing Cornell a 48-23 loss on Homecoming. Individually, the Hawks boasted the only running back tandem in the FCS with two 1,000-yard seasons. Additionally, junior quarterback Brandon Hill threw for the second most yardage and touchdowns in school history.

The 2012 campaign saw the Hawks defeat a Colonial Athletic Association team for the second straight season with a 41-6 rout of The University of Rhode Island. Individually, quarterback Kyle Frazier finished his career by rewriting many single season Monmouth records while six Hawks earned all-conference honors. Once again the Hawks were impressive in the classroom, with the team registering an overall grade point average of 2.99 and 15 Hawks earning NEC Academic Honor Roll.

In 2011 the Hawks posted a undefeated record on the road for just the third time in program history, going a perfect 5-0. On September 17th, the Hawks knocked off 2012 NCAA Semifinalist Villanova, 20-9 for one of the marquee wins in the program's short history. MU had five players on the All-NEC Teams, including wide receiver Neal Sterling who was named NEC Offensive Rookie of the Year. The Hawks also boasted a pair of finalists for Jerry Rice Award, given to the nation's top FCS freshman. MU was the only team with more than one player named as a finalist. Senior captain Jose Gumbs, a three-time all-league selection, capped off his stellar career by being named Third Team All-America while finishing third all-time in tackles.

In 2010 the Hawks were four points away from posting seven wins, with four one-point losses. Off the field Callahan's team had the best grade point average among all the Northeast Conference football squads while a member of the Hawks earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors for the 11th straight season. Six different players earned a spot on the All-NEC teams, including offensive guard Shawn Wright's fourth consecutive honor.

On Oct. 31, 2009, Callahan and the Monmouth program reached another milestone as the Hawks recorded the 100th win in program history with a win over Bryant University at Kessler Field. Defensive back Jose Gumbs earned Northeast Conference Defensive Player of the Year as a redshirt sophomore; while five other Hawks earned spots on NEC All-Conference teams. David Sinisi ended his career by breaking over 30 school records, while becoming the NEC all-time leader in scoring and rushing yards. The two-time Walter Payton Award candidate led all active Division I football players (FBS and FCS) in scoring and led all active FCS players in yards rushing, rushing yards per game and rushing touchdowns. Academically, 22 Hawks were named to the NEC Academic Honor Roll and Jon Stolarz and Andrew Musick were two of just 53 FCS players named to the NACDA Academic All-Star Team.

Callahan led the Hawks to their 10th winning season in 2008, finishing



with a 7-4 overall record and a 6-1 NEC mark. Monmouth started the season with three straight losses, including losing to the CAA's Rhode Island and NCAA playoff team Maine by a total of seven points, but rallied to win seven of its final eight games. In conference play, the Hawks outscored their opponents 210-134, losing only to eventual league champion Albany. MU earned three major conference awards for the first time in program history, with Sinisi (then a junior) earning Offensive Player of the Year after finishing second in the NCAA in rushing. Sinisi, who ended the season tied for first among all FCS players in scoring, was one of 16 players in the nation named to the Walter Payton Award watch list. Gumbs was named Defensive Rookie of the Year while nine total Hawks earned All-NEC honors. In the classroom, Kevin Walsh, the Defensive Player of the Year, and center Andrew Musick, were named to ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District II team for the second straight year.

The 2007 season found the Hawks facing one of their toughest schedules, including a road contest against Delaware, who went on to the FCS National Championship game. Callahan's squad lost half of its starters from 2006's NEC Championship team but armed with a load of young talent, the Hawks won three of their last four games and had 10 athletes recognized as all-conference performers. Callahan's squad boasted the top passing attack in the NEC, while Monmouth's turnover margin of +12 was 12th in all of the Football Championship Subdivision. Monmouth's defense, complete with nine new starters, allowed the fewest first downs among conference members.

In 2006, Callahan led the Hawks to their first ever outright Northeast Conference Championship, their third in four years. Monmouth finished the season going 10-2 overall and 6-1 in conference play, earning a bid to play in the first ever Gridiron Classic, which was held at Kessler Field. The Blue & White defense finished first in Division I-AA in scoring defense, allowing just 12.67 points per game. A number of Hawks earned individual awards in 2006, with three players being named to the Sports Network Mid-Major All-America teams and three players named All-East Region from Don Hansen's football Gazette. Callahan also earned his third NEC Coach of the Year award, as the Hawks placed 11 players on the All-Conference teams. He was inducted to the Jersey Shore Hall of Fame after the 2006 season.

Coach Callahan's squads also excelled in 2003 and 2004. In 2004, the Hawks won their first-ever I-AA Mid-Major National Championship as they were awarded The Sports Network Cup following a 10-1 campaign. The 2004 season also brought MU their second consecutive NEC title and the fourth in the program's history with a 6-1 mark in league action.

In 2003, Callahan led the Blue and White to its first-ever post-season action, a 12-10 loss to Duquesne in the ECAC Football Classic. Along the way, he coached Monmouth to the best start in school history (8-0) and the most wins in school annals (10-2). With the success, which included a share of the school's third league title, Callahan was named the NEC Coach of the Year for the second time in his career. He was also named Coach of the Year by the New Jersey Sports Writers Association.

In 1998, Callahan was first recognized for his coaching excellence as he was tabbed the NEC Coach of the Year after leading the Hawks to their second NEC championship in three years. The team established over 30 new school records that season and featured one of the top offenses and defenses in Division I-AA.

Prior to accepting the head coaching position at Monmouth in August of 1992, Callahan served as assistant coach at Colgate University for eight seasons. He also had coaching stops at Wagner, Syracuse and The University of Albany.

Callahan was a two-year standout on the playing field at the University of Rochester. He roamed the Yellowjackets' defensive backfield from 1975 to 1976. He earned a bachelor's degree in history from Rochester in 1977.

Callahan and his wife, Ann Marie, reside in Spring Lake with their two children.
