TODAY'S GAME:

Monmouth heads to North Charleston for the first time in program history to face Charleston Southern in the Big South opener for each team. The Hawks are coming off a 31-24 win over preseason Northeast Conference favorite Bryant University while Charleston Southern had a bye week to prepare for MU. Today's game begins a three-game stretch in which Monmouth will face the top-three teams from the Big South over the past three seasons, including a pair of ranked opponents in Liberty and Coastal Carolina. The Hawks took a 14-0 lead in the first quarter against the Bulldogs but found themselves tied up at 24-24 late in the fourth quarter. Monmouth broke the tie with 1:16 to play on a 50 yard touchdown pass from Cody Williams to Reggie White Jr.. Charleston Southern, who comes into today's game with a 3-1 record, recently overcame a halftime deficit to defeat rival The Citadel on September 26.

The Hawks begin their second season in the Big South today after finishing the non-conference portion of their schedule with a 2-3 overall record. Junior running back Lavon Chaney is coming off his best game as a Hawk, finishing with 170 total yards of offense and a career-high 140 rushing yards. The opportunistic Hawks defense have forced 12 miscues on the season, including three interceptions in last week's game against Bryant. Safety Mike Basile and linebacker Payton Minnich continue to anchor the Monmouth defense, with the duo ranking second and ninth in the Big South in tackles, respectively. MU was selected sixth in the Big South preseason coaches poll after finishing 1-4 in the league last season.

Charleston Southern is looking to remain undefeated at home this season, having outscored Division II North Greenville and FCS startup East Tennessee State 88-21 in their previous two home contests. Offensively, Coach Jamey Chadwell's unit is second in the league and seventh in the NCAA with 272 yards per game on the ground. CSU has averaged 34.3 points per game in 2015, which is third in the Big South and 22nd among FCS teams. The Bucs' defense, led by preseason all-conference selection Aaron Brown is ranked 10th in the country in total defense, allowing 290.0 yards per game.

INSIDE THE MONMOUTH-CHARLESTON SOUTHERN SERIES

Today marks the second time that the Hawks and the Bucs have faced, with Charleston Southern taking the first matchup by a 27-0 score. The game, played in driving rain storm, saw the Buccaneer defense hold Monmouth to 112 total yards of offense. CSU quarterback Austin Brown ran for a pair of scores and was part of a potent rushing attack that racked up 338 yards on the ground. Monmouth quarterback Brandon Hill completed 14 of 28 passes, throwing a pair of interceptions. Running back Lavon Chaney had 13 rushes for 43 yards on the day while Tyler Thompson had a career-high 12 tackles, including nine solo stops.

MONMOUTH AGAINST THE BIG SOUTH CONFERENCE

In February of 2013 Monmouth University officially accepted an invitation to join the Big South Conference as an associate member in the sport of football. The Hawks are looking for their second conference victory after defeating Gardner-Webb in last year's season finale on Kessler Field.

Last season Monmouth went 1-4 in their first season as a Big South member. MU lost in the fourth quarter to both Liberty and Presbyterian, fell to today's opponent Charleston Southern at home and were overpowered by then-number one ranked Coastal Carolina on ESPN3. Prior to joining the league, MU was 0-3 all-time against members of the Big South with losses to Coastal Carolina in 2008 and 2009 and Liberty in 2013.

JOHN SIECZKOWSKI EARNS BIG SOUTH DPOW

Monmouth junior linebacker John Sieczkowski earned Big South Defensive Player of the Week after giving the Hawks an eight point advantage on an interception return in the fourth quarter. Sieczkowski registered just two tackles on the afternoon, but his biggest contribution came in the fourth quarter when he intercepted Bryant quarterback Dalton Easton deep in Bryant territory and returned it five yards for a touchdown that put the Hawks up 24-16 with 11:32 to play in the fourth quarter. It was his first interception of the year and his second career interception. Both of Sieczkowski's tackles were for losses, including one for a loss of four yards.

WHITE JR GIVES MU THE WIN, THEN GETS ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Redshirt freshman Reggie White Jr. was named Crons Brand Freshman of the Week after his career day against the Bulldogs, which culminated in his game-winning touchdown with 1:16 remaining. He broke the tie open on a screen pass, dodging through defenders then turning on the jets for a 50 yard touchdown, his second of the day. Earlier in the game, White Jr. gave the Hawks a 14-0 lead when he hauled in a 16 yard fade pass from Cody Williams in the second quarter. The redshirt freshman recorded his first career two-touchdown game and finished with 85 yards receiving, also a career best. He currently is second on the Hawks in receptions and yardage, with 21 catches for 235 yards.

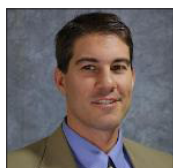
DID YOU KNOW?

Through five games Monmouth is ranked first in the Big South and sixth in the NCAA in turnovers gained with 12. The Blue & White have recovered four fumbles and intercepted opposing quarterbacks eight times. The Hawks are -1 on the year in turnover margin.



CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

HEAD COACH JAMEY CHADWELL



Jamey Chadwell is in his third year as the head football coach at Charleston Southern, owning an overall record of 21-8. In his first season the former ETSU quarterback led CSU as high as No. 12 in the FCS Coaches Poll, the highest ranking in school history. He led CSU to a school-record 10-3 mark, earning Big South

Coach of the Year honors. AFCA Region II Coach of the Year, and a spot as a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award. The Bucs spent the final seven weeks of the season in the coaches' poll and finished the year ranked for the first time in school history at No. 22. Chadwell, the third head coach in CSU history, spent five seasons at CSU as an assistant coach prior to his head coaching stints at North Greenville and Delta St.

THE LAST TIME OUT...

CHARLESTON S. 27 MONMOUTH 0

Nov. 1, 2014 • Monmouth Stadium • West Long Branch, NJ

WEST LONG BRANCH, N.J. - Charleston Southern quarterback Austin Brown ran for a pair of touchdowns as the Buccaneers defeated the Monmouth University football team, 27-0, Saturday afternoon on a rain-soaked Kessler Field at Monmouth Stadium. With the loss, the Hawks fall to 5-3 (0-2 Big South), while Charleston Southern improves to 6-3 (1-2 Big South).

The Buccaneers racked up 338 yards on the ground, with Ben Robinson and Mike Holloway finishing with 91 yards apiece. Robinson also punched in one touchdown. Christian Reyes also finished with 70 yards, while Brown accounted for 54 rushing yards to go along with 73 passing yards. Nathan Perera had three receptions for 35 yards for the Buccaneers, while Chris Theodore had two catches for 30 yards.

Lavon Chaney (Edgewater, Md./South River) led the Hawks with 43 rushing yards, while also hauling in five receptions. Hakeem Valles (Sicklerville, N.J./Peddie School), Eric Sumlin (Dover, Del./Dover) and Neal Sterling (Belmar, N.J./Manasquan) had two receptions apiece, with Valles finishing with a team-high 37 yards.

Tyler Thompson (Union Bridge, Md./Linganore) led the Monmouth defense with 12 tackles, while Mike Basile (Brick, N.J./Brick Memorial) and John Sieczkowski (Manalapan, N.J./Manalapan) had eight tackles apiece.

After a scoreless first quarter, Charleston Southern got on the board when Robinson punched it in from one yard with 13:37 left in the second quarter. The touchdown run punctuated a five-play, 60-yard drive covering 2:07. On the Hawks' next possession, CSU's Malcolm Jackson intercepted Monmouth quarterback Brandon Hill (Audubon, N.J./Audubon [UMass]), setting up the Buccaneers at the Monmouth 25 yard line. Six plays later, Brown ran it into the end zone from a yard out with 9:10 left in the half, giving CSU a 14-0 lead.

The Buccaneers made it a three-score game with 5:23 left in the third quarter, when Brown capped a 10-play, 74-yard drive with 12-yard touchdown run on an option keeper. CSU kicker David Kennedy capped the scoring with a pair of 34-yard field goals in the fourth quarter.

CODY WILLIAMS PACING BIG SOUTH FR RECORD

Monmouth redshirt-freshman quarterback Cody Williams is second in the Big South with 239.6 yards of offense and third with 199.0 passing yards a game; pacing ahead of the Big South freshman records in both categories. Williams is looking to become the first freshman QB in league history to average 200 yards of offense, while his passing yards per game is ahead of the record of 188.3, set by VMI's Johnathan Wilson in 2003.

CHANEY RECORDS CAREER DAY VS BRYANT

Monmouth running back Lavon Chaney ran the ball 23 times for a career-high 140 yards, with a long of 31 yards. Chaney also had three receptions for 30 yards, including a 25 yard catch and run. It was the first time this season and the fourth overall time Chaney has eclipsed the 100 yard mark. Chaney now has 1,214 career yards, 65 yards away from moving into 10th all-time in rushing yards at MU.

JOHNSON RECORDS SEVENTH CAREER INT

Senior cornerback Joe Johnson recorded his second interception of the season and the seventh of his career, moving him into a tie for six place with former Hawks Mike Pitts and Rob Lamoriello. His 159 career return yards and 22.7 return yard average is tied for third all-time on the Hawks.

BASILE MAKES IT THREE STRAIGHT OF 10+

Safety Mike Basile recorded his third straight game and fourth overall with double digit tackles. The sophomore had 10 tackles against Bryant and currently leads the Hawks with 53. Basile currently ranks second in the Big South in overall tackles.

SAFETY RANKED THIRD IN THE NCAA IN SOLO STOPS

Basile ranks third in the NCAA in solo tackles with 7.5 per game through the first five games and 18th in total tackles per contest.

WHITE SETS FIELD GOAL CAREER MARK

Kicker Matt White booted a career long 40 yard field goal in the third quarter, battling winds that reached 30 mph at times. He also had two of his 3 punts land inside the Bulldog 20 yard line, including one that was downed on the one yard line. That punt set up Sieczkowski's INT return.

FOURTH DOWN EFFICIENCY

The Hawks have been incredibly efficient on fourth down this season, converting 14-of-18 opportunities. That is good enough for a 78.0% success rate, which ranks 8th in the country. Only two teams have attempted more fourth down conversions than the Hawks and teams are 0-for-1 against Monmouth's defense on fourth down.

LAVON CHANEY MOVING UP THE ALL-TIME TD LIST

Junior running back Lavon Chaney scored on a pair of runs from 13 yards and 7 yards against Fordham. The two scores gave Chaney 12 career rushing touchdowns, moved him into ninth all-time past Bobby Smith (11). He is now just one behind Jim Varick for eighth.

UNPRECEDENTED SUCCESS FOR THE BIG SOUTH

The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 56 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24). The league has also had two teams ranked at the same time for six consecutive weeks this season, as Liberty is No. 15 in both the FCS Coaches poll and STATS ranking this week. The conference has had two teams nationally-ranked in the same week 29 times overall in league history -- including 24 times since the start of the 2013 season.

UP NEXT FOR THE HAWKS

Monmouth returns home for back to back games against ranked teams starting with Liberty on October 17 before top-ranked Coastal Carolina visits West Long Branch on October 24. Both games will be featured on ESPN3.

WEST LONG BRANCH, NJ – Redshirt freshman quarterback Cody Williams connected with sophomore wideout Reggie White, Jr. on two touchdowns, including a 50-yard screen pass for the go-ahead score as the Monmouth University football team outlasted Bryant, 31-24, Saturday afternoon at a rain-soaked Monmouth Stadium. Williams also ran for a 22-yard touchdown as the Hawks improved to 2-3 on the season. Bryant falls to 2-2 with the loss.

Lavon Chaney rushed 23 times for 140 yards and added three receptions for 30 yards. Williams finished with 70 yards on the ground. Fifth-year senior Pat Gray caught five passes for 40 yards, while Darren Ambush made four receptions for 37 yards.

Mike Basile had a team-high 10 tackles and a quarterback hurry, while John Sieczkowski returned an interception five yards for a touchdown and added two tackles for loss. Anthony McDonough also added six tackles, including 1.5 for loss. Joe Johnson chipped in with an interception, a pass breakup and five tackles, while Malcolm Powers also added an interception.

Bryant quarterback Dalton Easton finished with 256 yards passing and two touchdowns, one each to Chad Ward and Jose Depadua. Ward led the Bulldogs with four receptions for 105 yards, while Depadua finished with 43 yards receiving. Taylor Barthelette made three catches for 41 yards and secured a two-point conversion from Easton. Ricardo McCray led Bryant on the ground with 94 yards and a touchdown.

Monmouth scored on its opening possession for the second time this season as Williams capped a 10-play, 75-yard drive with a 22-yard scamper on 4th-and-2. Matt White's extra point was good as the Hawks took a 7-0 lead at the 11:20 mark of the first quarter. A 14-yard Chaney run and a 12-yard reception by Ambush got the Hawks into Bryant territory, before Williams drew the Bulldogs offside on 4th-and-1 to again move the sticks, setting up the redshirt freshman quarterback's touchdown run on the next set of downs.

After Monmouth stopped Bryant short of the 50, the Hawks moved 12 plays for 85 yards covering 6:01 on another touchdown drive. Williams converted a 3rd-and-6 with a 25-yard swing pass to Chaney, getting the Hawks into Bryant territory. He then completed a six-yard pass to Ambush on 3rd-and-3 to move the chains. Williams picked up another fourth-down conversion with a nine-yard run on 4th-and-6 from the Bryant 25. On the next play, Williams found Reggie White, Jr., in the back, left corner of the end zone for 16 yards and the score. Matt White's extra point was good, putting Monmouth on top, 14-0, at the 3:04 mark of the first.

After both teams saw their next drive stall, Bryant moved 67 yards on five plays over 2:16 to get into the end zone. McCray ran four times for 57 yards, including a 38-yard run off left tackle for the score. The extra point was good, making it 14-7 Monmouth with 12:56 left in the second quarter.

Bryant capped a seven-play, 54-yard drive when Easton connected with Depadua over the middle for a 19-yard touchdown on 3rd-and-7 to tie the game at 14-14 with 6:30 left in the second quarter. Easton's 18-yard pass to Keenan Thompson got the Bulldogs into Monmouth territory, before a 15-yard connection with Barthelette gave Bryant another first down at the Monmouth 22.

Monmouth took a 17-14 lead with 6:15 left in the third, when White hit a career-long 40-yard field goal with the wind at his back. Williams converted the Hawks' third fourth-down opportunity of the game with a 27-yard run into Bryant territory on the drive.

The Bulldogs downed the punt at the Monmouth 1 and Chaney was tackled a yard deep in the end zone for a safety on the Hawks' first play from scrimmage, cutting Monmouth's lead to 17-16 with 2:05 left in the third quarter.

Monmouth later returned the favor in the punting game, with Matt White pinning the Bulldogs inside the one early in the fourth quarter. Bryant couldn't move beyond the one, with Easton's pass on 3rd-and-10 being tipped and intercepted for a pick six by Sieczkowski. The senior linebacker returned it five yards for the touchdown and Matt White's extra point was good, giving Monmouth a 24-16 lead with 11:32 left.

Bryant took little time to respond, with Easton connecting with Ward on play action for a 68-yard touchdown pass on the Bulldogs' first play from scrimmage. Bryant successfully went for two, with Easton rolling out to the right to find Barthelette to tie the game at 24-24 with 11:12 remaining.

The only head coach in the history of football at Monmouth, Kevin Callahan has developed a winning tradition in West Long Branch. Callahan, whose 126 wins is 13th among active coaches at the FCS level, ushered in a new era for MU football when the Hawks joined the Big South Conference in 2014.

Beginning his 23rd season at the helm of the Hawks, Callahan has amassed a 127-104 record while his teams have captured five conference titles in the past 18 seasons. Along the way, Monmouth has been ranked among the top 20 in total offense on two occasions and in total defense five times. Meanwhile, numerous players have earned conference, regional and national honors. Regarded as an outstanding coach by his peers, Callahan served as the President of the FCS Football Coaches Committee in 2007-08 and has been a member of the committee since 2002. Under his watch, six former Hawks have earned spots on NFL rosters, including All-Pro wide receiver Miles Austin of the Philadelphia Eagles. Most recently, wide receiver Neal Sterling became the second Hawk to be drafted when the Jacksonville Jaguars took him in the seventh round of the 2015 NFL Draft.

Callahan led the Hawks to a 6-5 record in 2014, including the programs first Big South Conference win on November 22, 2014 against Gardner-Webb. Six student-athletes earned All-Big South honors, including freshman safety Mike Basile and senior wide receiver Neal Sterling being named First Team. Basile was also named Big South Rookie of the Year, while running back Lavon Chaney became the first newcomer to lead the league in all-purpose yards in six years. Off the field Joe Johnson was named to both the Big South and Capitol One All-District II Academic teams.

In 2013, Monmouth's first season as an independent since the 1995 season, the Hawks faced their most daunting schedule. Playing a 12-game regular season for the first time in program history, the Hawks opened with No. 2 Montana State- the highest ranked opponent that MU has ever faced. The season also saw the Hawks host an Ivy League opponent for the first time, with Monmouth handing Cornell a 48-23 loss on Homecoming. Individually, the Hawks boasted the only running back tandem in the FCS with two 1,000-yard seasons. Additionally, junior quarterback Brandon Hill threw for the second most yardage and touchdowns in school history.

The 2012 campaign saw the Hawks defeat a Colonial Athletic Association team for the second straight season with a 41-6 rout of The University of Rhode Island. Individually, quarterback Kyle Frazier finished his career by rewriting many single season Monmouth records while six Hawks earned all-conference honors. Once again the Hawks were impressive in the classroom, with the team registering an overall grade point average of 2.99 and 15 Hawks earning NEC Academic Honor Roll.

In 2011 the Hawks posted a undefeated record on the road for just the third time in program history, going a perfect 5-0. On September 17th, the Hawks knocked off 2012 NCAA Semifinalist Villanova, 20-9 for one of the marquee wins in the program's short history. MU had five players on the All-NEC Teams, including wide receiver Neal Sterling who was named NEC Offensive Rookie of the Year. The Hawks also boasted a pair of finalists for Jerry Rice Award, given to the nation's top FCS freshman. MU was the only team with more than one player named as a finalist. Senior captain Jose Gumbs, a three-time all-league selection, capped off his stellar career by being named Third Team All-America while finishing third all-time in tackles.

In 2010 the Hawks were four points away from posting seven wins, with four one-point losses. Off the field Callahan's team had the best grade point average among all the Northeast Conference football squads while a member of the Hawks earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors for the 11th straight season. Six different players earned a spot on the All-NEC teams, including offensive guard Shawn Wright's fourth consecutive honor.

On Oct. 31, 2009, Callahan and the Monmouth program reached another milestone as the Hawks recorded the 100th win in program history with a win over Bryant University at Kessler Field. Defensive back Jose Gumbs earned Northeast Conference Defensive Player of the Year as a redshirt sophomore; while five other Hawks earned spots on NEC All-Conference teams. David Sinisi ended his career by breaking over 30 school records, while becoming the NEC all-time leader in scoring and rushing yards. The two-time Walter Payton Award candidate led all active Division I football players (FBS and FCS) in scoring and led all active FCS players in yards rushing, rushing yards per game and rushing touchdowns. Academically, 22 Hawks were named to the NEC Academic Honor Roll and Jon Stolarz and Andrew Musick were two of just 53 FCS players named to the NACDA Academic All-Star Team.

Callahan led the Hawks to their 10th winning season in 2008, finishing



with a 7-4 overall record and a 6-1 NEC mark. Monmouth started the season with three straight losses, including losing to the CAA's Rhode Island and NCAA playoff team Maine by a total of seven points, but rallied to win seven of its final eight games. In conference play, the Hawks outscored their opponents 210-134, losing only to eventual league champion Albany. MU earned three major conference awards for the first time in program history, with Sinisi (then a junior) earning Offensive Player of the Year after finishing second in the NCAA in rushing. Sinisi, who ended the season tied for first among all FCS players in scoring, was one of 16 players in the nation named to the Walter Payton Award watch list. Gumbs was named Defensive Rookie of the Year while nine total Hawks earned All-NEC honors. In the classroom, Kevin Walsh, the Defensive Player of the Year, and center Andrew Musick, were named to ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District II team for the second straight year.

The 2007 season found the Hawks facing one of their toughest schedules, including a road contest against Delaware, who went on to the FCS National Championship game. Callahan's squad lost half of its starters from 2006's NEC Championship team but armed with a load of young talent, the Hawks won three of their last four games and had 10 athletes recognized as all-conference performers. Callahan's squad boasted the top passing attack in the NEC, while Monmouth's turnover margin of +12 was 12th in all of the Football Championship Subdivision. Monmouth's defense, complete with nine new starters, allowed the fewest first downs among conference members.

In 2006, Callahan led the Hawks to their first ever outright Northeast Conference Championship, their third in four years. Monmouth finished the season going 10-2 overall and 6-1 in conference play, earning a bid to play in the first ever Gridiron Classic, which was held at Kessler Field. The Blue & White defense finished first in Division I-AA in scoring defense, allowing just 12.67 points per game. A number of Hawks earned individual awards in 2006, with three players being named to the Sports Network Mid-Major All-America teams and three players named All-East Region from Don Hansen's football Gazette. Callahan also earned his third NEC Coach of the Year award, as the Hawks placed 11 players on the All-Conference teams. He was inducted to the Jersey Shore Hall of Fame after the 2006 season.

Coach Callahan's squads also excelled in 2003 and 2004. In 2004, the Hawks won their first-ever I-AA Mid-Major National Championship as they were awarded The Sports Network Cup following a 10-1 campaign. The 2004 season also brought MU their second consecutive NEC title and the fourth in the program's history with a 6-1 mark in league action.

In 2003, Callahan led the Blue and White to its first-ever post-season action, a 12-10 loss to Duquesne in the ECAC Football Classic. Along the way, he coached Monmouth to the best start in school history (8-0) and the most wins in school annals (10-2). With the success, which included a share of the school's third league title, Callahan was named the NEC Coach of the Year for the second time in his career. He was also named Coach of the Year by the New Jersey Sports Writers Association.

In 1998, Callahan was first recognized for his coaching excellence as he was tabbed the NEC Coach of the Year after leading the Hawks to their second NEC championship in three years. The team established over 30 new school records that season and featured one of the top offenses and defenses in Division I-AA.

Prior to accepting the head coaching position at Monmouth in August of 1992, Callahan served as assistant coach at Colgate University for eight seasons. He also had coaching stops at Wagner, Syracuse and The University of Albany.

Callahan was a two-year standout on the playing field at the University of Rochester. He roamed the Yellowjackets' defensive backfield from 1975 to 1976. He earned a bachelor's degree in history from Rochester in 1977.

Callahan and his wife, Ann Marie, reside in Spring Lake with their two children.

MU ANNOUNCES 2015 CAPTAINS

On Tuesday of last week, Monmouth Head Coach Kevin Callahan announced the 2015 team captains would be seniors **Hakeem Valles, Ed Royds, Andrew Jurczynski** and **Joe Johnson**. Valles, who moved to tight end last season, starting nine games and finishing in the top-five in receptions and reception yardage. Royds had 171 yards on 22 rushes but was one of the most integral parts of special teams, finishing second in kickoff return yards while making 14 tackles on special teams. Johnson, a two-year starter at cornerback, led the team in interceptions in 2014 and finished fourth on the team in tackles with 45. Jurczynski appeared in seven games as a defensive lineman last season.

HAWKS CHOSEN SIXTH IN PRESEASON POLL

Monmouth University was picked to finish sixth in the 2015 Big South Preseason Coaches Poll. Coastal Carolina was picked to win the conference earning 15 first place votes and 139 total points. Right behind them was Liberty with 129 points and six first place points followed by Charleston Southern (106 points) and Presbyterian (72). Gardner-Webb was chosen fifth with 57 points while Monmouth was just four points behind with 53. First year program Kennesaw State was picked seventh with 32 points.

Monmouth finished 6-5 overall and 1-5 in conference in 2014, its first season in the Big South. In addition to Basile and Sieczkowski, the Hawks had five other members earn all-conference honors. MU returns nine starters on defense and six starters on offense, including junior RB Lavon Chaney.

BASILE TIES CAREER MARK FOR TACKLES

First Team All-Big South safety Mike Basile tied a career-high with 10 tackles against the Crusaders. Basile, who earned Big South Rookie of the Year honors in 2014, also tied his career mark for solo tackles with nine. Last season Basile was second on the team with 78 tackles but first in solo stops with 59.

WILLIAMS CLOSE TO SETTING FIRST TIME STARTER RECORD

Last week's Holy Cross game began the Cody Williams era as the Hawks' starting quarterback. Over the 23 seasons of football, Monmouth has had 15 different starting quarterbacks (QBs which started a significant number of career games), with only four earning wins in their first starts. Williams' 258 yards against the Crusaders ranks second behind Dan Sabella's 263 in 1994. The Springfield, Mass. native became the first freshman to start at quarterback for Monmouth since the 2009 season when Kyle Frazier started against Wagner.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

Monmouth welcomes a pair of new coaches to the sideline for the 2015 season. Scott Lakatos, formerly of Georgia and Rutgers, will mentor a deep secondary in 2015 while former Colgate Raider Andrew Kirkland will coach the outside linebackers. The 2015 season marks the return of Head Coach Kevin Callahan coaching a position, handing the middle linebackers. Defensive Coordinator/Associate Head Coach Andy Bobik will coach Monmouth's defensive line this season.

THREE HAWKS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH

Redshirt junior John Sieczkowski and sophomores Mike Basile and Alex Thompson were each selected to the preseason All-Big South team. Basile was a First Team selection and Sieczkowski was a second team pick in 2014. Monmouth was the only school to have sophomores featured on the all-conference preseason team. Basile, who hails from nearby Brick Township, was the Big South Defensive Rookie of the Year in 2014. Sieczkowski and Basile started every game last season while Thompson started 10 of 11 games as a true freshman in 2014.
